### STUDENTS' RESIDENCY AGREEMENT FORM FOR HOSTELS

The University agrees to provide you with the room allocated to you on the terms and conditions outlined in the university's Student Handbook's residency policy or other approved Extracts. In addition, the following conditions shall apply to your residency in the University's Hall of Residence:

**Damage to the University Facilities:** In the event of any damage to the University's facilities within the Room, Floor, and Hall you are allocated, the University reserves the right to surcharge you fully, individually or jointly for such damages resulting from your collective or individual carelessness, negligence or willful misconduct.

Loss of Personal Property/University Facilities: In the event of any loss of University Facilities within the Room, Floor, and Hall you are allocated, the University reserves the right to surcharge you fully, individually, or jointly for such loss resulting from your collective or individual carelessness, negligence or willful theft.

**Keeping of Valuables:** Valuables such as Laptops, I-pad, and iPods shall be registered with the Dean of Student Affairs.

#### Permit to be in Residence

Your residency in the Hostel is non-transferable:

- Do not harbor another student or any visitor in the Hall.
- Do not sublet all or any part of the residence allocated to you.
- You are not to transfer from one room, floor or Hall to another without due authorization from the Dean, Student Affairs.
- Note, however, that you can be transferred from one Room, Floor or Hall to another, and/or change your bed at any time within the Session after due authorization from the Dean, Student Affairs.
- In the event of being transferred to a room different from the one that was originally allocated to you, the terms and conditions of this agreement shall remain in full effect without necessitating the execution of a new agreement.

**Responsibility Clause:** It is mandatory as a responsible student of the University to:

(i) Report any event of damage to property occasioned by regular use by students at any time.

Report cases of malicious damage of University's property

- a. I shall pay to the University or jointly, the cost of any repair or replacement to any property damaged to my knowledge and for which I did not report.
- b. I agree to face the maximum disciplinary penalty for any such complicity.
- (ii) Watch over property directly in my care or within my surrounding and ensure the responsible usage of such property.

**Termination of Residency by the University:** The University may terminate this agreement and your right to residency in the Hall in the event of any material or persistent disregard by you to any of the rules and regulations set forth in the Policy on Residency.

**Modification to Policy on Residency:** The University reserves the right to revise and amend the rules and Regulations set forth in the Student Handbook at any time during the Academic Session for which this agreement is executed.

#### **DRESS CODE**

All students are expected to dress modestly at all times on and off campus.

- Bump shorts, crop tops, and mini-skirts are prohibited.
- All short dresses (above the knee length) must be worn over "leggings"
- "Leggings" must be worn with shirts or dresses that cover the buttocks
- Raggedy jeans/clothing are not allowed for both males and female students
- Transparent shirts/blouses must be worn with the appropriate inner shirts
- Skirts and trousers that are too tight, revealing the entire body structure are not allowed
- Only braided hair or wig above shoulder level is allowed
- Male students are expected to wear a shirt, trousers, and a tie (the tie could be optional because of the weather)
- Male students must be clean-shaven at all times.
- Coloured/tinted hairs (gold, pink, blue, green, etc.) are not allowed
- Unnecessary high hair and dreadlocks are not allowed
- Sagging of trousers is not allowed
- All male students are prohibited from wearing earings
- No female student shall be allowed to carry unnecessarily decorated long nails
